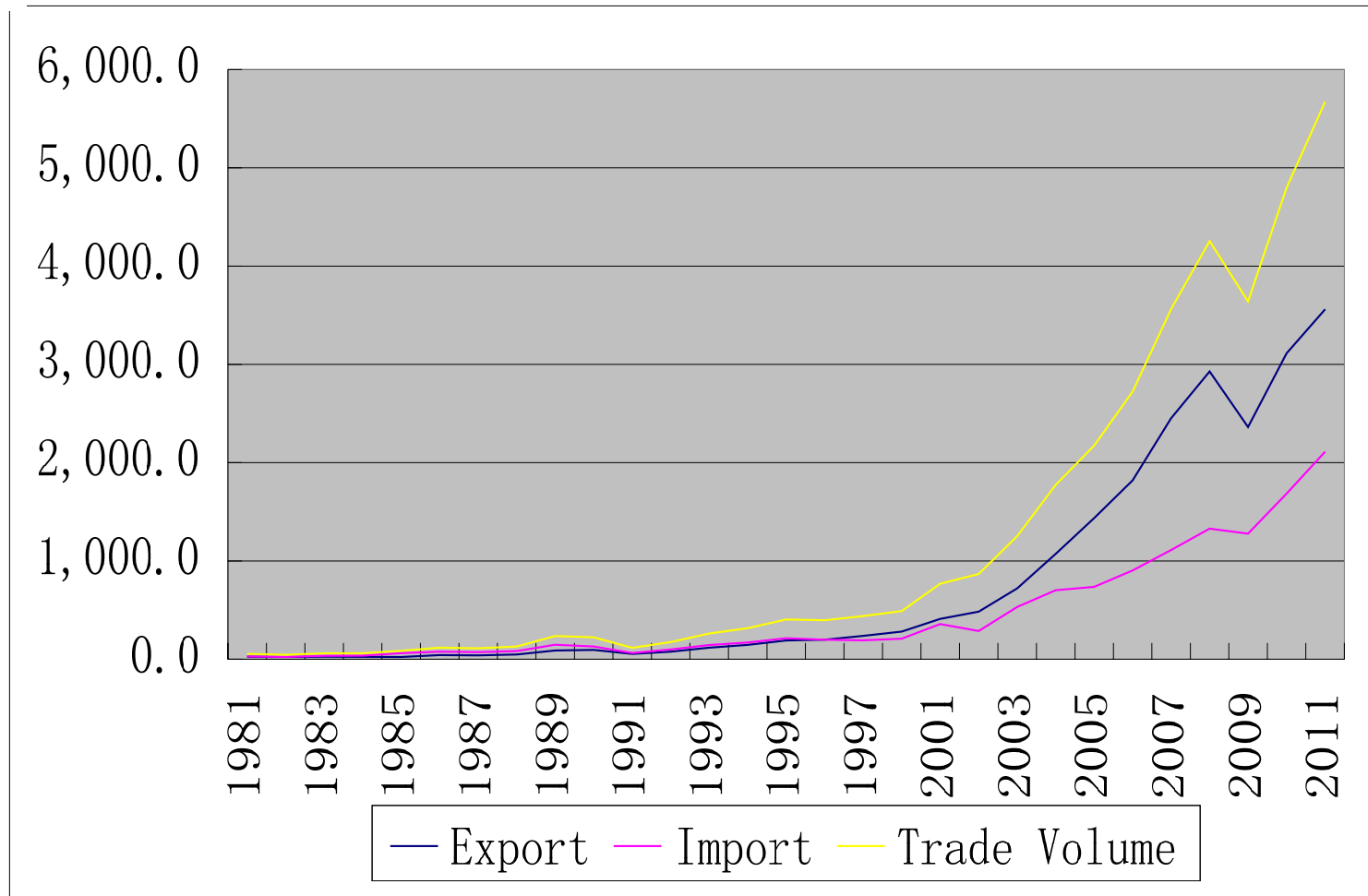

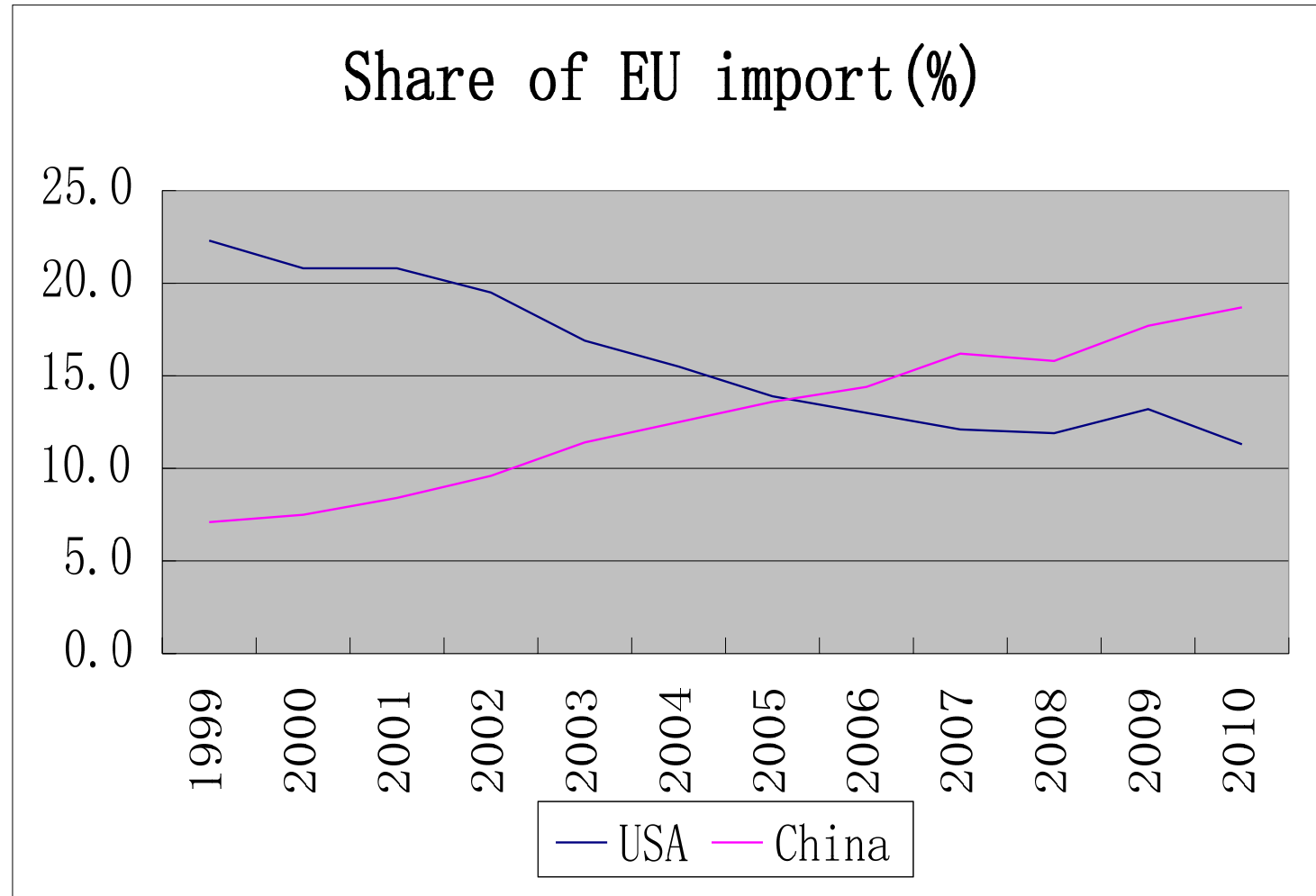

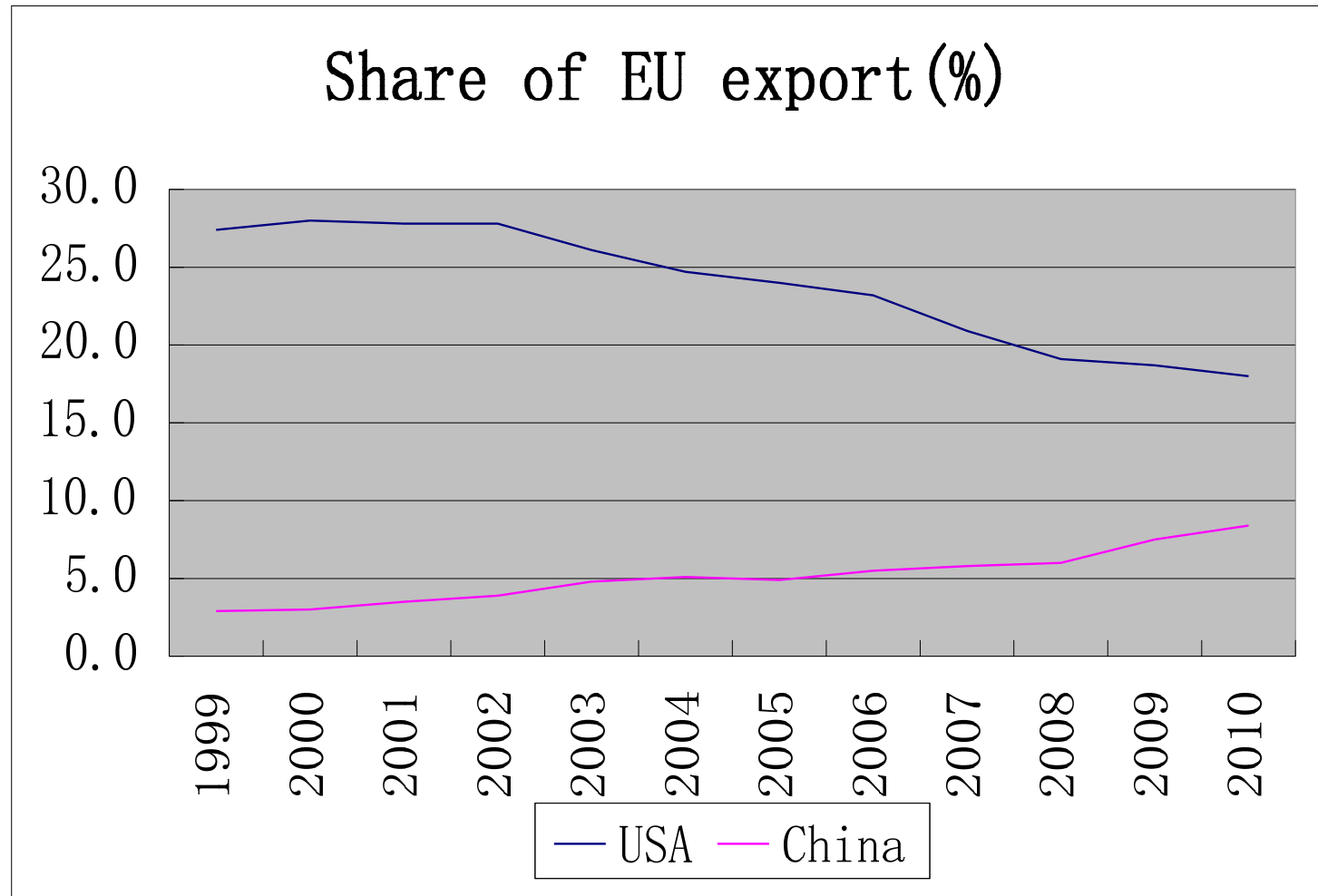
China's share in EU's import is increasing

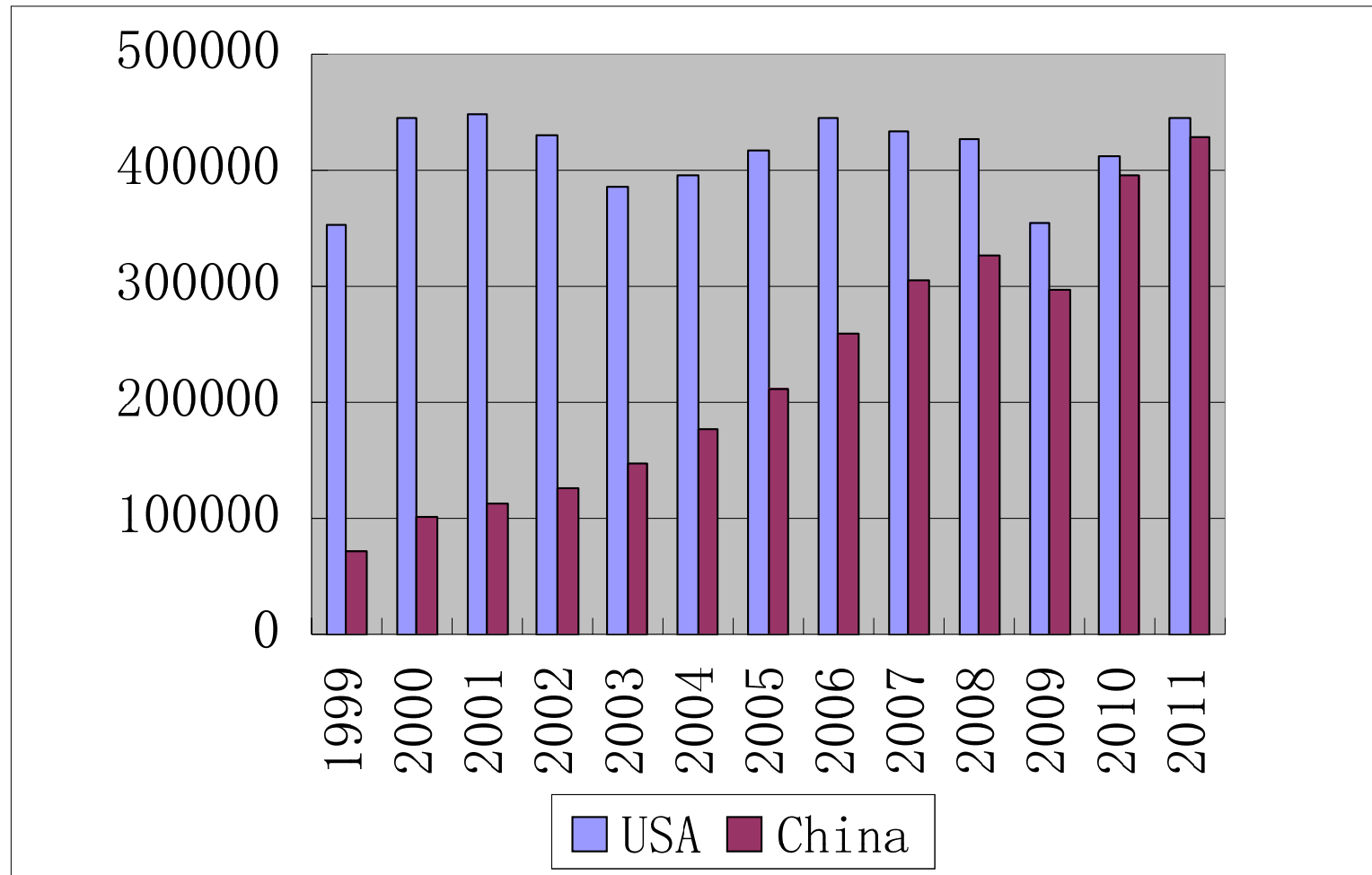
and China's share in EU's export is increasing

German example

- Germany takes 30% of the China-EU trade, where represents 21% China's export to EU27, and 44% China's import from EU27.
- China-German trade increased 19% in 2011, in which export increased 12% and import 25%.
- In China-EU trade, China has a surplus, whereas in China-German trade, China has a deficit. In 2010, it was 6 billion USD, and 16 billion in 2011



Investment: another German example

- By the end of 2011, German investment in China is 21 billion Euro with 5500 JVs, and at the same time China has less than 1 billion Euro investment in Germany with 800 enterprises in Germany, 70% of them are SMEs.
